In order to be considered for this grant, please provide the following information:

- Title of the research project
- Purpose of the research
- The problem or issue of focus
- The research questions being asked
- The research methodology being used
- The proposed budget for the research project

Responses must not exceed 1000 words total, and must be submitted electronically by May 15 to Sylvia Dresser, Executive Director of ACCT, [Sylvia@acctinfo.org](mailto:Sylvia@acctinfo.org).

Submitted proposals will be reviewed and ranked by a panel of industry professionals. Criteria for awards will include the relevance of the research to the industry and the appropriateness of the research design. Applicants will be notified no later than July 1 regarding the status of their research proposal.

A practitioner oriented article for the ACCT newsletter, *Parallel Lines*, will be expected from the recipient for the issue following the completion of the research. The research results may also be presented at the ACCT conference if desired.
